As part of the Ada County Highway District's (ACHD) maintenance program, streets (even new streets!) are chip sealed to protect them from water and weather damage, so they stay in good condition.

What is a chip seal?

A chip seal is the process of applying a new layer of liquid asphalt and chips (small rocks) to the street, followed by a sealant.

IMPACTS



On-street parking will be temporarily restricted. Watch for the “No Parking” signs.



High speeds can cause rocks to fly & fresh asphalt to splatter your vehicle.

While most work will be done during the week, some larger, busier roads will be chip sealed on the weekend to minimize impacts to businesses and the traveling public.

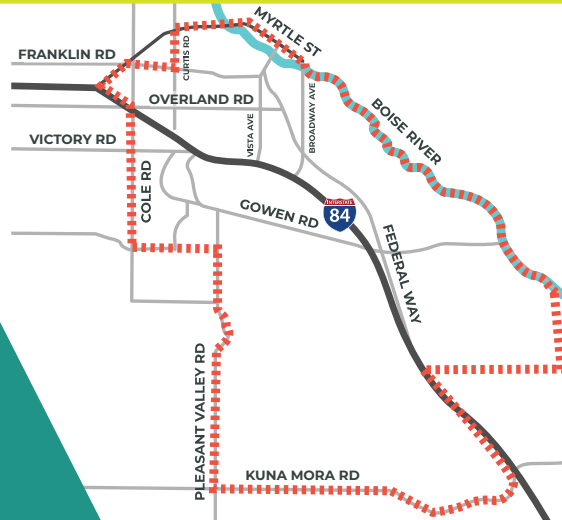
